GCUB CHANGE OF NAME

The name of the Association Coimbra Group of Directors of Brazilian Universities was changed on October 30, 2020, by the unanimous decision of its General Assembly held on the same date.

The new corporate name and trade name are, respectively: Brazilian Association of Directors of Higher Education Institutions for International Cooperation, and International Cooperation Group of Brazilian Universities. However, the acronym has not changed and remains GCUB.



PROGRAMS

From November 2020 to April 2021, the GCUB promoted three mobility programs. They offered 928 vacancies and 520 scholarships in 60 universities.



10TH EDITION OF THE BRAZIL PAEC OAS-GCUB SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAM

On December 21, 2020, the Call for Applications of the 10th Edition of the Brazil PAEC OAS-GCUB Scholarship Program was published.

Through this Program, Brazilian universities associated with the GCUB offered scholarships for Master's and Doctorate degrees to citizens of the 34 OAS member countries (except Brazil).

The Brazil PAEC OAS-GCUB is the largest training program for Masters and Doctors in the Americas.

In this edition, 41 Brazilian universities associated with the GCUB offered 361 scholarships: 233 for Master's Degrees and 128 for Doctorate Programs.

A total of 1578 applications were received, and 297 candidates were selected: 206 for Masters and 91 for Doctorate. The courses will start in 2021 or 2022.

The platform for receiving and evaluating applications was developed by the Center for Public Policies and Education Evaluation at the Federal University of Juiz de Fora (CAEd/UFJF).

The GCUB is extremely grateful to the CAEd/UFJF for their support and attention, as well as to all universities participating in the Program.

PROAFRI SECOND EDITION

On March 26, the Call for Applications GCUB/ProAfri no. 001/2021 was published. It regulates the selection of candidates for the second edition of the Training Program for Higher Education Professors from African Countries - ProAfri.

ProAfri aims to support professors from Mozambican universities through academic scholarships for Masters and Doctorate degrees offered by Graduate Programs of Brazilian universities associated with GCUB.

In this edition of ProAfri, 25 Brazilian universities participated and offered 128 scholarships: 81 for Masters and 47 for Doctorate.

Registration closed on April 30 and 186 applications were registered.

Universities will analyze the merits of applications from May 20 to June 18, 2021. The final result will be published on July 12, 2021.

PROLAC FIRST EDITION

On April 28, the Call for Applications of the 1st Edition of the Training Program of Higher Education Professors for Latin America and the Caribbean - ProLAC was published.

ProLAC is promoted by GCUB in partnership with the *Unión de Universidades de América Latina y el Caribe* - *UDUAL*, with the support of UNESCO / IESALC. Its objectives are:

- Contribute to the strengthening of Higher Education and scientific and technological production, in Latin America and the Caribbean;
- To favor the development and integration of the Region by increasing the number of doctors in Higher Education Institutions.



In this first edition of ProLAC, 40 universities associated with the GCUB or UDUAL offered 439 vacancies and 31 scholarships for Ph.D. programs. <u>Registrations are open until May 28, 2021.</u> Professors from Higher Education Institutions associated with GCUB or UDUAL can apply.

COURSE OF INTRODUCTION TO CHINESE CULTURE

The Course of Introduction to Chinese Culture was promoted from September 02 to December 09, 2020, in partnership with the Hebei Foreign Studies University (China). The course gathered 50 undergraduate students from 39 universities associated with the GCUB. The course total workload was 45 hours.

Under the coordination of Professors Ana Qiao (UFF/Hebei Normal University) and Rossana Valéria de Souza e Silva (GCUB), the course had the following objectives:

- Get to know relevant aspects of Chinese culture to understand the way of living, thinking, and acting of Chinese people.
- Understand how cultural differences interfere in personal, professional, academic, scientific, and commercial relationships between individuals.

The course had 126 participants, including managers, professors, graduate students and administrative staff, from 30 Brazilian universities associated with GCUB.

On April 14-22, 2021, the GCUB promoted the Training Course for Leaders in International University Cooperation -

Module 1: The Swiss Experience, in partnership with the University of Geneva (Switzerland).

Module 1 of the Course covered the different leadership concepts in Higher Education and presented the Swiss experience concerning the theme of internationalization and international university educational cooperation. Its coordination was in charge of Professor Abdeljalil Akkari (University of Geneva) and Professor Rossana Valéria de Souza e Silva (UnB / GCUB).

The course gathered 36 participants from 29 institutions located in 7 countries, including 20 universities associated with GCUB. The attendees were professors, managers, technical-administrative staff, and doctoral students from Brazilian and foreign universities, in addition to a representative of the Brazilian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

WORKSHOPS CYCLE IMPROVE YOUR KNOWLEDGE ABOUT TOEFL IBT EXAMS

In October and November 2020, the GCUB promoted three workshops of the "Improve Your Knowledge About TOEFL iBT Exams" cycle, in partnership with the Educational Testing Service - ETS, the organization responsible for applying the TOEFL iBT and GRE tests worldwide.

The TOEFL iBT preparatory workshops covered the four skills assessed in the exam: Reading, Listening, Speaking, and Writing.

For this cycle of workshops, 1080 registrations were received and 635 undergraduate students from 42 universities associated with GCUB were selected.

The target audience was English Language professors linked to the universities associated with GCUB and students enrolled in the last year of the undergraduate course in Languages-English.

158 registrations were validated. A total of 137 professors and students from 33 Brazilian universities associated with GCUB participated in the two workshops.


