

# Annex 1 - Additional Benefit granted by the Organisation of Southern Cooperation (OSC)

## Call for Applications No. 001/2025 for GCUB-Mob

The Executive Director of the International Cooperation Group of Brazilian Universities - GCUB, in the use of her legal attributions, considering the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding between the GCUB and the Organisation of Southern Cooperation (OSC), includes the following information to the GCUB-Mob Call for Applications No. 001/2025:

1. That the OSC shall work with the GCUB to finance up to 400 (four hundred) one-time allowances, subject to the availability of funds, for candidates selected in the GCUB MOB Program Call for Applications No. 001/2025, who are citizens of the following Founding and Member States of the OSC, as listed below:
  - a. **Afghanistan**, Islamic Republic of
  - b. **Cambodia**, Kingdom of
  - c. **Comoros**, Union of
  - d. **Congo**, Republic of
  - e. **Djibouti**, Republic of
  - f. **Eswatini**, Kingdom of
  - g. **Ethiopia**, Federal Democratic Republic of
  - h. **The Gambia**, Republic of
  - i. **Jordan**, Hashemite Kingdom of
  - j. **Nicaragua**, Republic of
  - k. **Nigeria**, Federal Republic of
  - l. **Palau**, Republic of
  - m. **Palestine**, State of
  - n. **Togolese** Republic
  - o. **Yemen**, Republic of
  - p. **Zimbabwe**, Republic of
2. In addition to the citizens of the countries mentioned in paragraph 1 above, eligible for the one-time allowance shall also be candidates selected in the GCUB-Mob Program who are citizens of the Republic of the **Sudan**, subject to the written notification of the OSC to GCUB after 4<sup>th</sup> July 2025.
3. Subject to the availability of funds, a one-time allowance of US\$ 750.00 (seven hundred and fifty US dollars) will be granted to each selected candidate. Should additional funds become available at the time of disbursement, the allowance may be increased accordingly. The payment will be made in Brazilian currency, calculated at the official exchange rate on the date the Organisation of Southern Cooperation transfers the funds to GCUB.



4. The selection of the up to 400 beneficiaries will be carried out by the Evaluation Advisory Committee for the Selection of the Third Phase of the GCUB-Mob Program Call for Applications No. 001/2025.
5. The final list with the result of the up to 400 beneficiaries will be published at the same date as the publication of the final result of the GCUB-Mob Call for Applications No. 001/2025.
6. These provisions are part of the GCUB-Mob Call for Applications No. 001/2025.
